DIRECTIONS:

- North or South on I-5 take exit 142B, west on 348<sup>th</sup> (becomes Campus Way after crossing 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. S.) Pool is on the right side approximately 1-1/4 miles from I-5.

FACILITY:

- Indoors 50-meter, 9 feet deep, 8-lane competitive pool is divided by bulkheads into two 25-yard courses.
- Diving pool will be available for continual warm-up/down.
- 2500 spectator seats.
- OMEGA Electronic Timing System
- Scoreboard (8 lane alpha numeric readout)

ONSITE AMENITIES:

- Heat Sheets: \$2.00 per session
- Final Sheets: \$1.00 per session
- Results: Complimentary posted on PNS web site
- Concessions: Snack bar is available throughout the competition and is controlled and operated under contract with King County Aquatic Center.

- Hospitality:** Refreshments will be available for coaches and officials in the hospitality room. Swimmers and spectators are not allowed.
- Parking:** Available at the Aquatic Center. Parking is not permitted in designated fire lanes and vehicles will be subject to towing and fines. Do not leave valuables in vehicles. If needed, overflow parking will be available at the Federal Way Little League Parking lot east of the Aquatic Center.
- RV parking:** Permits must be obtained for RV parking and a per night charge may be assessed. Limited RV parking only in the north parking lot at designated locations. Contact Aquatic Center Management for permit. 206 296-4444. **RV hookups are not permitted.**

COACHES:

- Coaches are required to show current USA Swimming Coach Registration if representing a USA Swimming Club or athlete.
- Current credentials must be visible at all times while on deck**
- Coaches' packets available at Clerk of Course desk.

OFFICIALS:

- Officials are required to show current USA Swimming Non-Athlete Registration and Certification.
- Current credentials must be visible at all times while on deck.**

MEETINGS:

- Coaches' meeting: 4:00 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 1, 2005 Admin Room.
- Officials' meeting: 60 minutes before each session except Thursday at 5:30 pm.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers must be registered with NCAA and/or USA Swimming or FINA equivalent.
- On-deck USA Swimming registration will not be permitted. All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the PNS Registration database.
- Swimmers must have met the minimum qualifying time standards.



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#### ENTRIES:

- Meet Management reserves the right to cap Individual swimmer participation in the meet at 600 swimmers if necessary to allow for adequate time between heats and finals. Entries are limited to a maximum of six (6) Individual events for the meet with a maximum of three (3) Individual events per day not including the 25 free exhibition event or relays.
- Meet Entry Summary and Meet Entry Fees must be submitted with entries by all teams by the deadline.
- NO entries will be accepted after the deadline.
- On deck USA Swimming registration will not be permitted.
- Deck entries for individual events or relays will be **NOT** allowed.
- Time Trials are Deck Entry only at \$7.50. Swimmers must be registered in the meet to sign up for Time Trials.

#### ENTRY SUBMITTAL:

Entries will only be accepted upon receipt of all of the following **prior to the entry deadline**:

- COMMLINK file exported from Team Manager (if used)
- Meet Entry Report for individual (sorted by swimmer) and relay entries from Team Manager (preferred) or equivalent hardcopy.
- Meet Entry Fee Report from Team Manager (preferred) or equivalent hardcopy
- Master Entry Summary form Completed and hand-signed hardcopy only (original or faxed); typed signatures will not be accepted
- Meet Entry Fees – One check please

#### • Submittal Formats:

- Electronic files:** email attachments (preferred) or disk. If emailing the COMMLINK file, include items #2 and #3 above in Word for Windows format in your email. Items #4 and #5 must still be received by the entry deadline.
- Hardcopies:** mail, hand-deliver or fax. If sending via express mail, please waive signature requirement.
- Disk:** 3½ inch floppy disk, double density or high density format, CD or DVD, and should be mailed or delivered using a protective envelope
- To ensure correct entries, teams that do not have Team Manager or equivalent software are encouraged to obtain a free of charge **Hy-Tek Lite** to complete and submit entries for this meet. This software is available at <http://www.hy-tek.com/downloads.html>

#### • Submittal Notes:

- Meet Entry Report or equivalent hardcopy must include: Full name of club, and, for each swimmer, first and last name, actual age as of first day of meet, gender, USA Swimming permanent 14-character identification number, events entered, and entry times
- Cooperation is appreciated in facilitating the entry process by making your entries complete, orderly, and legible.

- Relays: \$15.00

- No refunds or credits will be given for events entered but not swum.

- All Meet Entry Fees must accompany entries.

#### AWARDS:

- Individual:** Husky Invitational Medals - 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Relays:** Husky Invitational Medals - 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Team:** Top two college teams and top two club teams - combined men's and women's scores.
- High Point:** Awards to top scoring male and female swimmers.
- 25 freestyle:** Special Award
- Presentation of Awards will take place immediately following conclusion of Championship heat. Coach of winning athlete will award top three medals to swimmers as they stand on their respective blocks.**

#### MEET RULES:

- Current USA Swimming rules will govern throughout the meet. Please note exception for Exhibition 25 free listed below.**
- The meet will be swum with prelims and finals except relays and the 1000 & 1650 freestyles which are single session timed finals. The 25 free exhibition is Preliminaries/Semis/Finals.**
- Prelims for the distance events may be swum with women and men in separate courses.
- Top 8 entry times in 1650 free will be swum in the finals session. The referee reserves the right to swim the remaining heats with two swimmers per lane if necessary to meet
- Finals will be conducted in one course only.
- Each swimmer must provide their own timer and counter for distance events. Lanes with no timers will swim without a backup timing system if automatic timing should malfunction.
- The top 16 entry times for the all relays will swim in the finals in event number order. 400 Freestyle Relays may be swum in both courses in prelims. Teams seeded in the top two heats of the 400 Free Relay will have the option to swim in prelims.



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▪ **The 25 Freestyle will be swum as follows:**

**Preliminaries** – Current USA Swimming Rules will govern starts. No false start rule applies.

**Semi finals** – One false start charged against the field. The 2nd false start will result in a disqualification. The first false start will be called back.

**Finals** – Two false starts against the field will be allowed. The 3rd false start will result in a disqualification. The first two false starts will be called back.

- The top 5 seeded heats of the 500 free and 400 IM will be swum in event number order in prelims slowest to fastest. The remaining heats will be swum at the conclusion of prelims fastest to slowest.

**SCRATCH PROCEDURES:**

- Swimmers not checking in for the 1000 freestyle or 1650 freestyle events will automatically be scratched without penalty.
- Swimmers checking in for the 1000 freestyle or 1650 freestyle events **who do not swim** will be scratched from their next scheduled individual or relay event.
- If a swimmer does not show up for a prelim heat without scratching, the result will be disqualification from the next individual or relay event.
- A swimmer who does not compete in a final event for which they have qualified without first declaring a false start to the deck referee, will be disqualified from all further competition for the duration of the meet.

**WARM-UP PROCEDURES:**

- Circle swim counter-clockwise only.
- Last half of each warm-up period
  - Lanes 1 and 8 - pace lanes (no diving starts)
  - Lane 2 and 7 - sprint lanes (dive starts - return in lanes 3 and 6)
  - Lanes 3,4,5,6 - general warm-up
  - Additional sprint lanes may be made available upon request to the Meet Referee
- Pool closes promptly 5 minutes before the start of competition.
- Warm-up may be modified at the discretion of the Meet Referee to accommodate the number of swimmers entered.

**SAFETY:**

- No Diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in main pool.
- Jumping into the pool is not allowed
- Backstroke swimmers enter the water feet first in rotation. No diving over persons in the water.
- Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up. Deck Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club from the warm-up or the meet who do not follow the safety rules.
- Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet - including warm-up and warm down.
- Swimmers who participate without their USA swimming certified coach present must notify the Meet Referee prior to warm-up. The swimmer will be assigned to a coach.
- **Team Areas: Please keep your area clean.**

**TIME TRIALS**

- Time Trials will be available as soon as possible after the conclusion of prelims subject to the referee's discretion. Due to the projected length of the 1650s there are no time trials on Sunday.
- Time trials will be scheduled to allow 1.5 hours for finals warm-up. In the event that time is limited, the time trials will be prioritized at the discretion of the referee.
- Time Trials will be arranged with the Clerk of Course and a \$7.50 fee per event paid to the Clerk of Course.
- Only swimmers registered for the meet who appear on the master entry form will be eligible.
- Each swimmer to provide a timer and counter, if needed.
- Lanes with no timers will swim without a backup timing system if automatic timing should malfunction.

**OTHER NOTES:**

- In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, the University of Washington and Husky Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Only authorized volunteers and meet personnel can remain on deck. All others must remain in the designated spectator area and are not allowed in the designated racing venue unless timing for an event or volunteering with the management of the meet.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet.
- Meet Evaluation forms will be available in the Coaches packet.

- The top 5 seeded heats of the 500 Free PRELIM will be swum in event number order, slowest to fastest. The remaining heats of the 500 free will be swum after events 13, 14, fastest to slowest. Finals will be swum in event number order.
- Top 2 seeded heats of 200 Free Relay and 400 Medley Relay will swim in finals.

- Top 2 seeded heats of 200 Medley Relay and top 2 seeded heats of 800 Free Relay will swim in finals.
